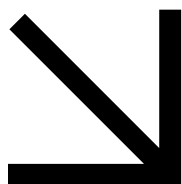

DEEP SURFACE

A conceptual exhibition featuring two artists working with paper, formed to bring together emerging Pilbara artist Amy Mukherjee with an established artist Susan Roux to give each the opportunity to share skills, collaborate and learn about each other's practice.

In dynamic ways, Amy Mukherjee and Susan Roux used the paper surface to deposit tensions, reflections and rhythms of the feminine experience, needling the viewer to face the depths of their own, raw self. In this exhibition, Susan Roux's heavily manipulated sculptural objects, punctured and distressed by the hand of the artist, complemented the honest and unadorned written word of Amy Mukherjee's intimate inner thoughts. As a contemporary exhibition, with each artist working in quite confronting and reflective ways, Deep Surface was curated to challenge the Hedland audience by extending their understanding of what contemporary art is and how it is presented.

This exhibition is Susan Roux's first regional exhibition, and for Jury Art Prize winner (Kathy Donnelly Award) Amy Mukherjee, this is also her first exhibition in Australia.

WEIGHTED/WAIT_[2020]

A community ceramics exhibition where hundreds of small cylindrical spheres were made by community members from all demographics and displayed as a covering of the main gallery floor. The concept for this exhibition is rooted in marking the year of COVID-19 and the subsequent changes and restrictions to everyday living, forcing communities to be still, and without movement.

The ceramic technique of 'pinch-pot' making was utilised to create each sphere, as it is an easily accessible and simple technique that children through to the elderly can utilise. A pinch pot can only be made to limit of the makers' hand size, which symbolises the 'hands of the community' coming together during this time.

A series of workshops were held in the lead up to the exhibition, both on site at the ceramic studio and out in the community.

FINDING HOME

An exhibition based on the Engaging Youth in Regional Australia study led by Dr Candice Boyd from the University of Melbourne and funded by the Australian Research Council. The research took place in three regional towns – Griffith NSW, Hedland WA, and Port Lincoln SA. Each of these towns is experiencing net youth outmigration despite their strong local economies. The research sought to better understand the reasons why young people leave these areas but also why some choose to stay, and others return.

The exhibition includes work by researchers and participants involved in the study and features handmade textiles by artist-activist Tal Fitzpatrick, and a collaboration between mother-daughter, Aboriginal artists Lorna Dawson and Kimberley McKie.

THE ART OF EVERYDAY

Presenting a myriad of possibilities, this visual celebration offered a glimpse into the infinite, timeless knowledge of WA Aboriginal arts and design whilst together, creating a contemporary language for a new era. Many artists and art centres in the showcase also see textiles and fashion as integral to future economic independence, developing new income streams through design, marketing and younger generations.

Privileging a Pilbara aesthetic, the project builds capacity and acknowledges the tremendous talent of the region including looks from Yinjaa-Barni, Kirrikin, Martumili, Spinifex Hill Artists, Port Hedland creatives and Juluwarlu. With many looks transcending the typical fast fashion framework, these timeless looks use fashion as a medium of an infinite lineage.

THE JURY ART PRIZE

A contemporary, curated annual art prize that showcases works across different mediums including painting, photography, sculpture, digital and mixed media. The prize is open to all regional West Australian artists. The Jury Art Prize 2021 was judged by industry experts, artist Damien Shen, multidisciplinary artist and poet Jazz Money and acclaimed curator Sandra Murray.

In addition to the physical exhibition at the Courthouse Gallery+Studio, members of the public were invited to engage with the prize through a virtual gallery and online voting system. The Jury Art Prize 2021 presented a 24 hour opening event, with winners announced throughout, interspersed with a range of other activities including candlelight yoga and live music. Artworks were showcased on a huge digital billboard in Perth's busy Yagan Square on opening night.

The Jury Art Prize is the highlight of the artistic calendar for regional artists across Western Australia, particularly those based in the Pilbara. It affords beginners through to established artists the opportunity showcase their work alongside their peers, exposing their work to industry professionals who provide valuable critical feedback.
